How to get to AIM:

Take I-465 to the west side of Indianapolis; exit on Rockville Road East (a fun 270 degree turn). Continue past Lynhurst. Be careful, there's a school on the right where patrol cars sit! The next light is Gasoline Alley and you can only turn left or continue on Rockville... turn left! Follow Gasoline Alley into the first S-curve, where you will see the huge AIM Tuning sign on the West/left side of the road. Turn left before the sign and then to the right and you are there! AIM is immediately behind Earl's.

From 16th Street: South on Poleco (across from the track) through two lights, curve to the right, and you're on Gasoline Alley. Look for the sign just past Earl's.
