About 2:45, we'll go to the parking lot and hand out instructions for the fun drive, which will be around 50 miles of 'rockin' n rollin' hills and curves, on the "Highway to Hill"! This will allow your Burritos to settle!

To get to El Rodeo from Indy, take SR 67 South towards Mooresville. Just before you get to Mooresville, you'll see a big Marsh on the left. This is Bridge Street. Turn Left on Bridge Street, then left into the Marsh Center. El Rodeo is on the opposite end of the Center.

If you aren't going to eat Mexican, just turn into the Marsh lot and meet in the parking area near El Rodeo. Be there around 2:45 to 3:00.

If you will just be arriving to Mingle and have some cool treats, we should arrive back at Ritters Frozen Yogurt in Mooresville anywhere from 4:30 to 5:00. Ritters is in the same area as Marsh and El Rodeo. SR 67 to Bridge St. Left into Marsh Center. Ritters is on the far end out by SR 67. Try to park in a good open area where all the Miatas can gather.

Cost: FREE! (except for the food and ice cream you eat!)

Meet at 1:30 for Mexican / lunch dinner (optional)

Meet 2:45 - 3:00 for handing out "fun drive" papers

Meet back at Ritters after the drive (4:30 to 5:00) for Mingling, reviewing the drive and having ice cream treats!
